

HOW COVID-19 AFFECTS WILDLIFE REHABILITATORS




LIMITED STAFF

In order to comply with local and state guidelines, many wildlife rehabilitators have significantly reduced their number of staff and are operating without volunteers.

LIMITED FUNDS

A majority of wildlife rehabilitators are not paid nor funded by the government, they rely solely on fundraising events to support animal care. As these events had to be canceled, the funds available to cover the costs associated with rehabilitation have been significantly reduced.



INCREASED WORKLOAD

Now with concerns over COVID-19, wildlife rehabilitators have had to ramp up their biosecurity protocols (even more than usual!) and problem-solve the additional required logistics.
